This form is required if the services will be conducted in the State of Arizona and exceed \$100,000 over five years.

5. RFP section 4.21 Administrative (Legal) Remedies. reads "The Arizona Board of Regents has promulgated Administrative (Legal) Remedies for alleged breaches or disputes arising from the Agreement.
